If any such person(s) visit your residence, please contact the Mount Vernon Police Department for enforcement action to be taken. You can request to be removed from the No Visit List at any time. The published No Visit List will only include your **physical address** (no name, phone number or personal information will be released).

Per City Code 605.020. Exception.

This shall not apply to a Federal, State or Local government employee or a public utility employee in the performance of his/her duty for his/her employer.

No Visit List – Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is the No Visit List?
The No Visit List is similar to the State and Federal No-Call List for telemarketers. The No Visit List establishes residences within the City of Mount Vernon that are essentially “off-limits to peddlers, solicitors and canvassers.
2. Can political issue/candidates or religious canvassers visit my residence after I sign up for the No Visit List?
No. All peddlers, solicitors and canvassers (including political and religious) must abide by the No Visit List.
3. Can handbills or flyers be left on my door or property?
No. The city ordinance specifically states that handbills and flyers can not be placed or left upon any property listed on the city’s No Visit List.
4. If I see someone going door to door, should I call the police?
No, probably not. If they are properly licensed (have completed an application and received a license from the City of Mount Vernon) they may conduct the door-to-door activities per their application. As long as they do not visit residences on the No Visit List, they are complying with the city ordinance.
